

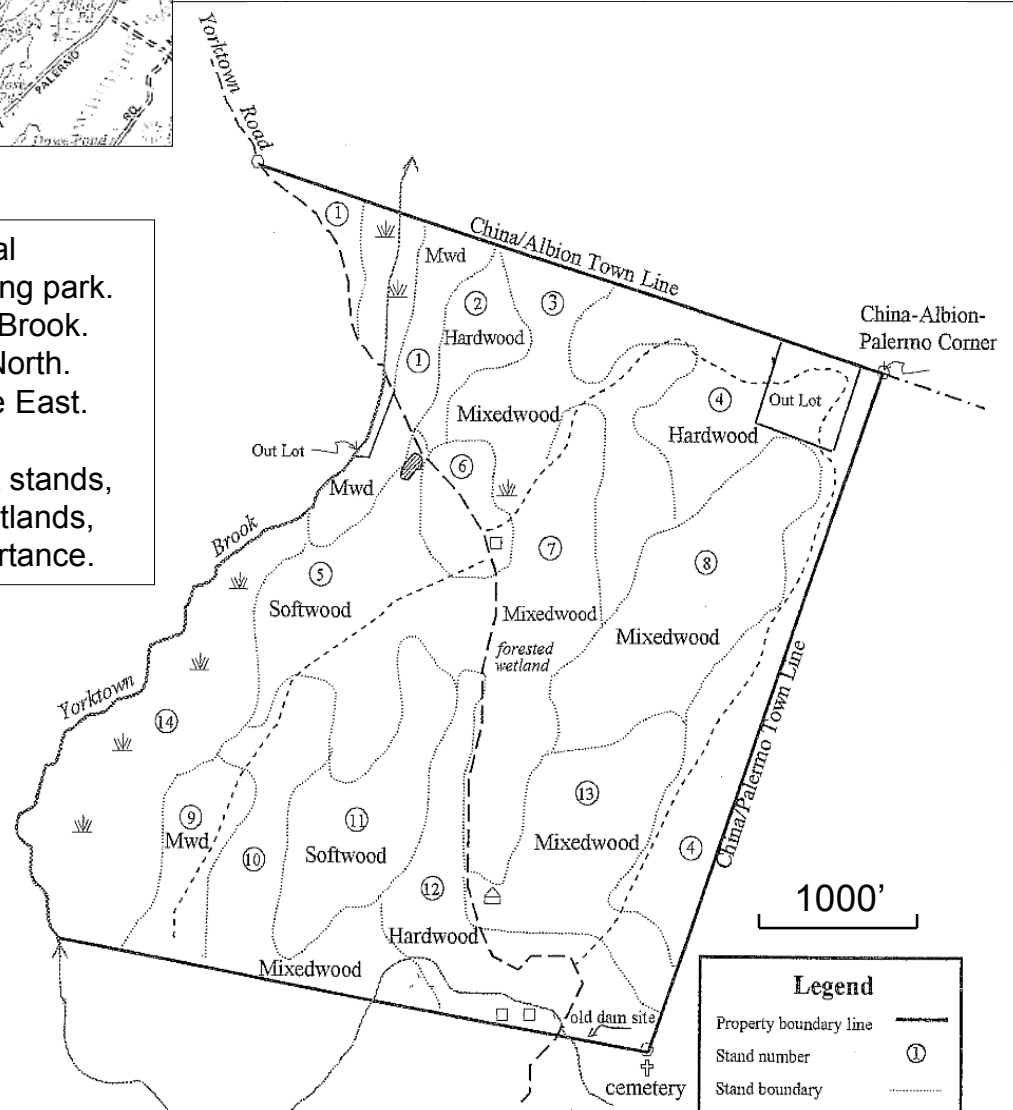
Thurston Park Access

North side: From the causeway, cross LakeView Drive. At fork stay R. on the Dutton Rd. Go about 2 mi. to Yorktown Rd (top of hill) and turn R, follow to the park.
 Challenges: steep hill, possible water over bridge at Yorktown Brook.

South side: Private driveway with town easement near end of Mann Rd (1 mi from intersection with Parmenter Hill and Pleasant View Ridge). Challenges: If muddy, impassable by car; about 15 minute walk to park property.

Map above shows general location, with star indicating park. Park is east of Yorktown Brook. Town of Albion is to the North. Town of Palermo is to the East.

Map to right shows forest stands, existing woods roads, wetlands, and sites of cultural importance.
